

**District 10 Tournament Oversight Committee  
Proposal to the District Board of Delegates  
Biloxi, MS February 2, 2008**

As promised at the September 2007 meeting of the District 10 Board of Delegates ("Board") in Tunica, the District 10 Tournament Oversight Committee ("Committee") review of the regional rotation is attached.

Need for Review. It has been a number of years since this issue has been addressed by the Board. The current regional rotation was set into motion in 1997. Many things have changed over the ensuing years, and a review of the rotation is overdue.

Decision-making Process. As previously announced, the following process has been chosen as the manner to address this issue:

1. At the Biloxi meeting on February 2, 2008, the Committee presented options on the regional rotation for the Board to consider.
2. Given the complexity of the issues involved, a comment period on the various options will be opened from the date of this report until April 1, 2008. All comments should be delivered to the Committee Chairman, Chuck Wilkinson. He can be contacted as follows:

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3. At the 2008 meeting in Hot Springs, the Committee will give its recommendation to the Board, and the Board will vote on the issue.

Criteria for review. Article II, Paragraph (E) of the bylaws of District 10 state that one of the objectives of our organization is "to allocate Regionals to the best interest of the membership of the District." The committee determined that the criteria that best measured this objective were as follows:

1. Attendance of D-10 members at each site.
2. Profitability of each regional site.
3. Geographic distribution of regional sites each year.

General Observations.

1. Table counts (See Exhibit A) at recent Nashville and Birmingham regionals have been impressive. These sites should be upgraded in the schedule. Likewise, table counts at Jackson, Shreveport and Mobile have been disappointing. These sites should be downgraded in the rotation.

2. Since District 10 regionals are primarily for the benefit of District 10 players, Exhibit B shows the number of District 10 players at each tournament. Exhibit C shows the percentage of D-10 players of the total players attending at each tournament. This percentage tends to be higher in our regionals in the southern portion of the district.
3. Profitability suffers with split regionals, as opposed to single site regionals. (See Exhibit D) However, total attendance improves.
4. Because of the large geographic area that District 10 covers, split regionals are necessary for our district in order to meet the third objective (See Criteria for Review above). Experience has shown that splits need to be far enough apart so as not to draw from the same pool of players. The committee chose 300 miles as the arbitrary minimum distance between split sites, but preferred sites to be at least 400 miles apart. See Exhibit E for the mileage between regional sites.
5. While Nashville remains the best split site candidate in the district, the committee felt that Hot Springs should also be considered as a split site. Hot Springs does not draw many D-10 players from more than 250 miles away, and it has a large active local bridge community. Table count @ Hot Springs would not suffer greatly if it were split.
6. Although other factors point toward reducing the frequency of regionals in Shreveport, some members of the Committee feel that the western side of D-10 would be under-represented if that was done.
7. The committee was also divided on the influence that accessibility to regionals outside of the district should have on the D-10 rotation. Exhibit F displays the number of regionals available to several D-10 cities over a 2-year period (2007 & 2008). Each delegate needs to decide individually on what influence this factor should be.
8. The current regional rotation will be in place through the year 2010. This proposal will cover the years 2011 through 2014. The committee recommends that the regional rotation be reviewed by the committee more frequently than in the past. Each option shows the regional rotation beyond 2014, but that is solely contingent upon subsequent approval by the D10 Board of Delegates at some future date.
